# HOW TO RECYCLE CALYX CONTAINERS

Here at Calyx Containers, our products are mindfully manufactured to minimize waste contribution. We'd love for you to reuse and repurpose your containers after use, but here's a handy recycling guide that will help you help us do our part in limiting packaging waste!



#### PLASTIC CONTAINERS WITH WHITE OR CLEAR LABELS

Labels don't need to be removed and can be recycled with the container

All materials, including ink and adhesive, are safe to recycle

Rinse away any flower and edible residue or the packaging may become non-recyclable



### PLASTIC CONTAINERS WITH METALLIC LABELS

Labels must be removed and thrown away before recycling the container

If metallic labels aren't removed, your local recycling facility might improperly detect the entire container as metal and not recycle it correctly\*

Be sure to rinse off flower or edible residue







#### CLEAR GLASS CONTAINERS WITH ALL LABEL TYPES

Remove all labels before recycling

Lids and glass jars should be recycled separately

Rinse flower and edible residue off your Calyx Jars and thoroughly wash your concentrate containers



## COATED GLASS CONTAINERS WITH ALL LABEL TYPES

Remove all labels

Lids should be separated from the base and recycled

Rinse away any residual flower and edibles and wash off all traces of concentrate

Coated glass is not recyclable—be sure to reuse your container!

\*All recycling requirements vary by location and should be checked in each municipality. Our plastic containers are fully recyclable in facilities that process polypropylene #5.



#### FEP-LINED LIDS

FEP Liners aren't recyclable and must be removed from lids prior to recycling

Follow recycling instructions for Plastic Containers

Wash the lid to remove any traces of your concentrate
